- I **Roll call:** Karie, Patti, Jodi, Jack; Heinrich and Triina via phone-in
- II. **Acceptance of Agenda** Karie moved to accept the agenda as presented; Patti seconded. Motion carried.
- III. **Acceptance of minutes from November 5, 2025;** Jodi moved to accept the minutes as presented; Patti seconded. Motion carried.
- IV. **Treasurer's Report:**
- A. Karie presented an invoice for Valley Lumber for \$67.34 for the cement for the bike fix-it station. Patti and Jodi will cut a check, and Karie will take it to Valley Lumber. Karie said Creek Water Construction will donate their time to lay the concrete, and she will send an invoice to Grace documenting the contribution.
  - B. Thumps up to everyone who worked on the bike fix-it station. Jodi said she learned about it on Facebook so it's in the public eye now.
- V. **Ongoing business:**
- A. Patti talked about restructuring DMPRD projects so that there is a lead person. Everyone agreed that it would be a good idea.
  - B. Grace reported on the mural committee's meeting on November 25, 2025. Things are just starting, and the next meeting is planned for Tuesday, January 13, 2026, at 10 am Up Top Café. Because the Rio Grande Headwaters Land Trust is planning two murals to start in 2026, DMPRD mural committee will work toward 2027.
  - C. Patti discussed Community Garden ideas. She will follow-up with a meeting of people who are interested in this project to determine how DMPRD wants to move forward.
  - D. Patti reported on her discussions with Kent Ford about a kayaking race course and river ideas. Jack will follow up with ideas for a river fest that could include a race course with temporary gates.  
Grace showed the email from Estevan Vigil about stocking fish. Grace will send a follow-up email to Estevan and copy Jack to clarify whether DMPRD could stock fish from the DN Town Park.
  - E. Grace emailed landscape architect Kelly Ortiz about a handicapped ramp to river.

F. Grace reported on progress toward improving the horseshoe pit. She has been in contact with Andrew of Bulwark Construction and will be meeting with him mid-January to see about a design. Karie said she would follow-up with a family member who plays horseshoes to see if he might be a part of the planning and feedback stage.

**New Business:**

A. In terms of integrating the handicap community in DN into the ramp committee, Karie and Grace will discuss with Hubba and Kathy Black whether they think there would be interest and a group of people willing to work on a committee. They will report back at the next meeting.

C. Max Jordon - Del Norte Bike Park

After lengthy discussion about the bike race summer 2026 and the bike park, it was decided that DMPRD would look into liability issues regarding DMPRD taking over the race(s) in summer 2026. Max will send Grace the land acquisition agreement and the liability waiver to see what the next steps might be.
