- I **Roll call:** Meeting began at 2:12 pm with Patti, Heinrich, Jodi, and Grace present.
- II. **Acceptance of Agenda** Patti moved to accept the agenda with the addition of the Splashpad under Ongoing Business I.; Jodi seconded. Motion carried.
- III. **Acceptance of minutes from December 3, 2025;** Patti moved to accept the minutes as presented; Jodi seconded. Motion carried.
- IV. **Acceptance of minutes from January 21, 2026:** None presented. So they will be reviewed at the next meeting in March.
- IV. **Treasurer's Report:** None presented.
- V. **Ongoing business:**
 - A. Update on Bike Park and Bike race - Heinrich will contact Keri and David Off and get a group of folks on board. DMPRD needs to look closely at the MOU and the liability form.
 - B. Update on Volleyball Court - Jodi feels that Ike's budget may be a bit low; Patti moved to spend \$10,000 on the volleyball court renovation, Jodi seconded; motion carried. Jodi will get on the Town's agenda for March in order to update them. DMPRD hopes to have an opening ceremony-tournament when the renovations are complete.
 - C. Update on the mural project - Grace reported that the Beauty Max wall has been tentatively chosen as the mural location. It is owned by KimAnna Cellura, and she has granted permission. The next meeting is February 9, 2026.
 - D. Update on Horseshoe pit - Grace will try to reduce the budget for the horseshoe pit renovations.
 - E. Update on Community Garden - Patti reported that various organizations are interested in the community garden and having a plot. Deann Sierra at the RG Hospital is interested in the project. The SLV master gardener group is interested. The SLV Native Plant Society is interested. Locations are being considered and the committee is forming.

- F. Update on Columbia St - Patti reported that the project is still in the works. She moved to spend \$15,000 total on the landscaping and upgrading of the median strip (\$8,695) and the trout sculpture (\$6,425).
- G. Update on river handicapped dock - Grace talked to Kathy Black who suggested we get in touch with Blue Peaks. DMPRD would like to place this potential project on hold for the time being.
- H. Update on stocking fish at the DN bridge of the RG - Grace reported that the CO Parks & Wildlife is managing the stocking of fish in the Rio Grande and is not interested in us getting involved.
- I. Splashpad - Patti reported that the splashpad committee via Leah Noga asked her about contributing to the effort as they need \$8,000 more than came in through the GoFundMe campaign for the 9-month old who died. Patti moved to contribute \$3,000 to the effort, Jodi seconded; motion carried.

New Business:

- A. Joining Special District Association of CO (SDA) \$350/year - Patti moved to join the Special District Association. Jodi seconded. Motion carried.
- B. Consider general liability insurance coverage through SDA -- must be a member, about \$1,400/year - Grace will find out more about coverage and report at the next meeting.
