- I. **Roll call:** Patti, Karie, Heinrich, Jodi (on phone), Grace, Shelly Burnett
- II. **Acceptance of Agenda items for April 1, 2026;** Karie moved to accept, Heinrich seconded; motion carried
- III. **Acceptance of minutes from March 4, 2026;** Patti moved to accept, Karie seconded; motion carried
- IV. **Treasurer's Report:**
- A. Quarterly financial report; Grace presented the report; all is in order. Patti moved to accept the financial report, Jodi seconded; motion carried
- V. **Ongoing business:**
- A. The group discussed and decided to make Grace DMPRD's official **volunteer** Executive Director. Karie moved to accept, Jodi seconded; motion carried.
- B. The group discussed changing our board meeting time and location; Karie moved to change our meeting time to 6 pm and to meet at Heinrich's shop (500 Columbia Ave.), keeping the same day - the first Wednesday of each month. Patti seconded. Motion carried.
- C. Grace presented the mural project at the DN Chamber of Commerce meeting on 3/31/2026 and asked for a letter of support. They voted to approve the request.
- D. Karie moved to join the DN Chamber of Commerce and pay the \$100 membership dues, Patti seconded; motion carried
- E. Grace reported that DMPRD got six submissions from artists and the mural committee will be meeting to make their decision on Friday, April 3rd.
- F. There was no update on the median project on Columbia because DMPRD is waiting for the town to make their decision about art in the public square.
- G. Various options for the volleyball court were discussed, including sod or sand. More work will be done to follow-up on the sand option. There is a work session with the town on April 8th at 5 pm.
- H. Patti reported that the RG Hospital is working closely with the garden committee to locate the garden near the garden dome at the hospital.
- I. Grace showed photos of the work that Kevin Suellentrop is doing to improve the horseshoe pits. He has taken this on as a volunteer.

J. Update on Bike Park - We decided that three bike races; one in June, July and August, would be good. Heinrich will be in charge of the fundraising with the production going to Rundle and Max. The group discussed hiring Bart Miller's firm. Patti moved to hire the firm, Karie seconded; motion carried. Heinrich will make sure appropriate signage is on the Off land so that Colorado's SB24-58 will cover liability on their land. In terms of the Land Use Agreement terms for the race, it might be appropriate for the agreement to stipulate what happens if the races peter out in a few years.
